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School Wide Routines

Student Handbook (pg 7 to 12)

Attendance and Punctuality

- Attendance is **compulsory**.
- Pupils are to be in school **by 7.30 am** for flag-raising ceremony.
- Parents are to **refrain** from taking children out of school for vacation during term time.
- Pupil is to submit **medical certificate (MC)** or other supporting documents (e.g. parent's letter) if he/she is absent from school.
- Only **5 parent's letter** will be accepted in a year.



School Attire and Appearance

- Pupils are to wear the prescribed **school uniforms** to school every day.
- On days where there are PE lessons,
 - pupils are allowed to report to school in **PE attire**;
 - female pupils are to wear **school's skorts** (with PE shirts) and change into the PE shorts during the PE lessons
- Pupils must have their **name tags** affixed to their school uniforms and PE shirts (above the school's logo as shown).

School-based Assessment Practices

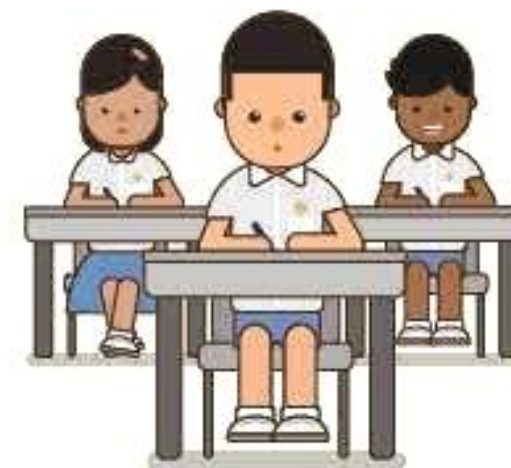
- **No Mid-Year Examinations (MYE)** for P3, P4 and P5.
- **Intent:**
 - reduce the load and stakes of school-based assessment (SBA)
 - move away from an over-emphasis on academic results
 - help our pupils to experience more joy and develop stronger motivation in learning
- Only **Weighted Assessments (WA)** and **End-of-Year Examinations (EYE)**
 - 1 WA per subject per term



Assessment Weighting Distribution

Primary 5

- **Term 1 WA: 15%**
- **Term 2 WA: 15%**
- **Term 3 WA: 15%**
- **Term 4 EYE: 55%**



School Assessment Policy

- Pupil who is **absent** on day of WA / EYE,
 - parent must inform form teacher before the start of the paper;
 - pupil must submit MC / official supporting document.
- Pupils must be **punctual** for all WA and EYE.
 - Pupil who is late on day with WA / EYE with no valid reason may not be allowed to sit for the paper.
- There will **not be any make-up** for papers missed by the pupils (except for oral examinations).

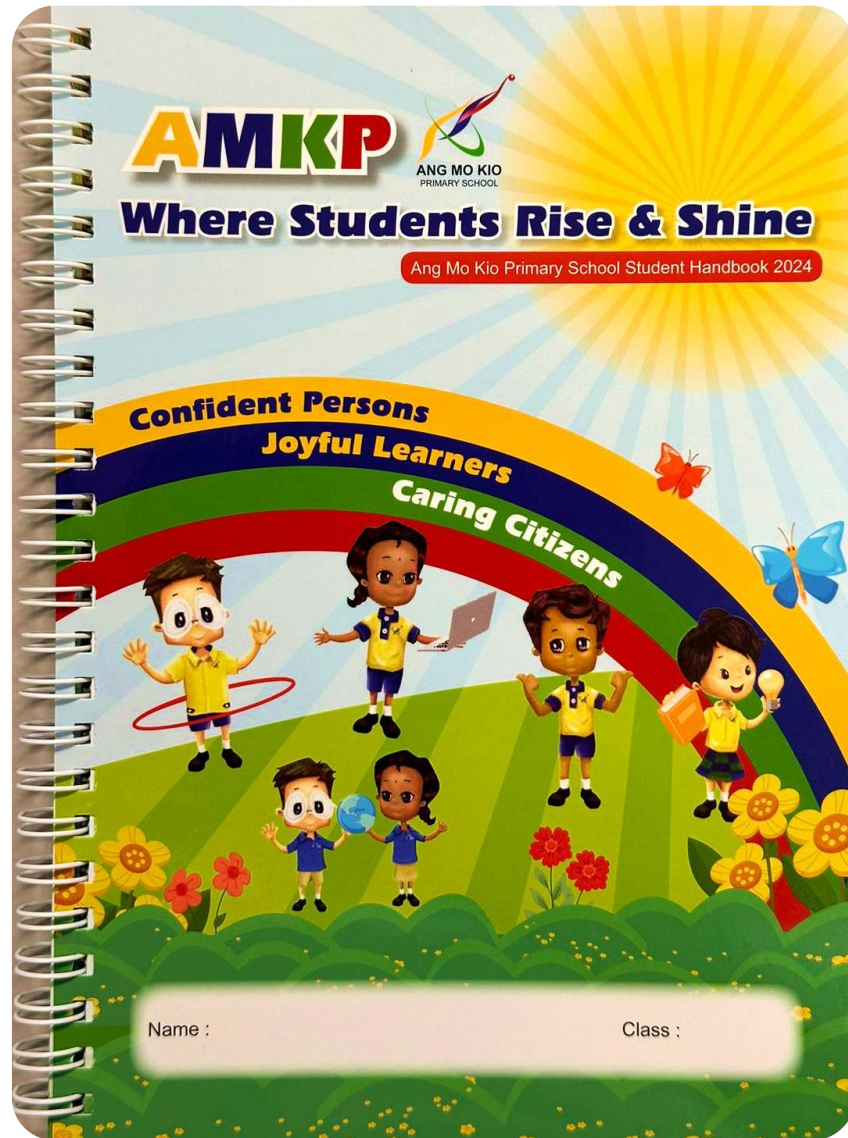
