2026 AMKP TERM 1 LETTER – TERM 2

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope the March holidays have provided your child/ward with a welcomed break. As we begin the new term, we would like to share relevant school matters and other key information.

2. **Recap of Term 1 Key Activities: Nurturing Hearts and Minds**

As we embark on Term 2, we remain committed to providing our students with a rich tapestry of learning experiences that extend beyond the classroom. Meanwhile, our Maker Education programme saw students developing problem-solving skills and creativity as they crafted DIY light-up cards using basic materials such as copper tape, LEDs, and coin batteries. Our vibrant cultural celebrations brought the school community together, with Chinese New Year and Total Defence Day festivities featuring lion dance performances, wushu demonstrations, and meaningful intergenerational connections with seniors from St Luke's ElderCare during calligraphy sessions.

Our Primary 6 students also took their science learning outdoors, exploring energy sources and conversion throughout the school campus, bringing science to life through real-world applications. Our commitment to global citizenship was demonstrated through our overseas immersion programme where we hosted teachers and students from Warraphat School, Thailand, fostering cross-cultural understanding and friendships. These carefully curated programmes develop 21st Century Competencies such as Civic, Global and Cross-Cultural Literacy in our students to prepare them for the real world. We look forward to sharing more exciting learning experiences with you, where every experience is designed to help our students grow as confident persons, joyful learners and caring citizens.

Detailed information on assessments and events will be issued later. We kindly request parents and guardians to enable notifications on the Parents Gateway app to receive timely information on school activities.

4. Attendance and Punctuality Expectations

Regular attendance has a significant impact on a child's learning and holistic development.

A child who is frequently absent will miss out on the learning experiences in school. It will also affect the bonds he/she forms with his/her classmates. Students are expected to be in school during term time unless he/she has taken ill or is excused for important private reasons. As such, we strongly discourage parents/guardians from taking their child out of school during term time. Please submit the medical certificate or valid documentation to the form teacher upon your child/ward's return to school after an absence. Please refer to our Student Handbook (page 8) for more details.

We strive to instil the value of punctuality in our students. **All students are expected to be in school by 7.30 a.m. Late arrivals (after 7.30 a.m.) will be recorded**, and a notification letter will be issued to parents for students who are late five times within five weeks. **We seek your help in ensuring that your child/ward comes to school punctually. Please note that persistent late-coming will affect your child/ward's overall conduct grade.** We also encouraged all students to report to school with a storybook (EL books on Monday and Tuesday and MT books on Wednesday and Thursday and a book of their choice on Friday) and to start their day by inculcating the positive habit of reading before flag raising.

5. MOE-wide Temperature-taking Exercise on 1 April 2026

To maintain schools' preparedness for potential re-activation of temperature-taking measures, an exercise will be conducted for all staff and students in Term 2 Week 2 on **Wednesday, 1 April 2026**. All students will be screened upon arrival in school. Those who are unwell will be required to seek medical attention and may only return to school when they have fully recovered.

6. Updating of Student Details Form

With reference to our Term 1 letter on the updating of your child's/ward's information including medical declaration via the Student Details Form (SDF), we would like to urge parents/guardians to complete the form by **Tuesday, 31 March 2026** if you have not done so.

Parents/Legal Guardians may login to the SDF portal using your Singpass account to submit your information and information of your child/ward. Authorised Caregivers can only submit your own information.



The SDF portal can be accessed via desktop computers or mobile devices such as laptops and mobile phones.

Please also note that the SDF portal will be accessible till the last day of Term 4 for you to provide timely updates of your information and/or your child's/ward's information.

7. Joint Traffic Advisory from the Land Transport Authority (LTA) and the School

With reference to our Term 1, 2026 letter dated 2 January 2026 and our subsequent letter dated 16 January 2026, the Land Transport authority (LTA) has observed vehicles parking or waiting outside the school along Ang Mo Kio Ave 3, particularly during school reporting and dismissal hours. LTA has also received feedback from the local community about the same matter. LTA does not permit any vehicle to park or wait along this road, except for quick student drop-offs. They have cautioned that enforcement actions will be taken against errant road users who flout traffic rules and regulations. In light of this, we appeal to parents and guardians to adhere to road safety guidelines. Your co-operation is crucial in ensuring the safety of every child and road user. Please refer to **Annex B** for the joint advisory from LTA and the school.

8. Visitor and Parent Engagement Protocols

a. Visitors to the School

All visitors, including our parents/guardians, **must enter the school through Gate C (next to the Security Guard House)** and report to the General Office to state the purpose of their visit. We seek your understanding that multiple entry points for visitors could compromise the security of the school premise and the safety of our students. **Visitors are permitted to move within the school compound ONLY when accompanied by a designated staff member, and expected to leave the premises promptly upon completion of their visit.**

b. Parent Support Group (PSG) and Parent Volunteers Involvement

We extend our heartfelt appreciation and gratitude to the Parent Support Group Executive Committee (PSG EXCO) and parent volunteers for their ongoing support. Your partnership and assistance with the various school programmes and activities in Term 1 have enabled the school to provide a well-rounded education for all our students.



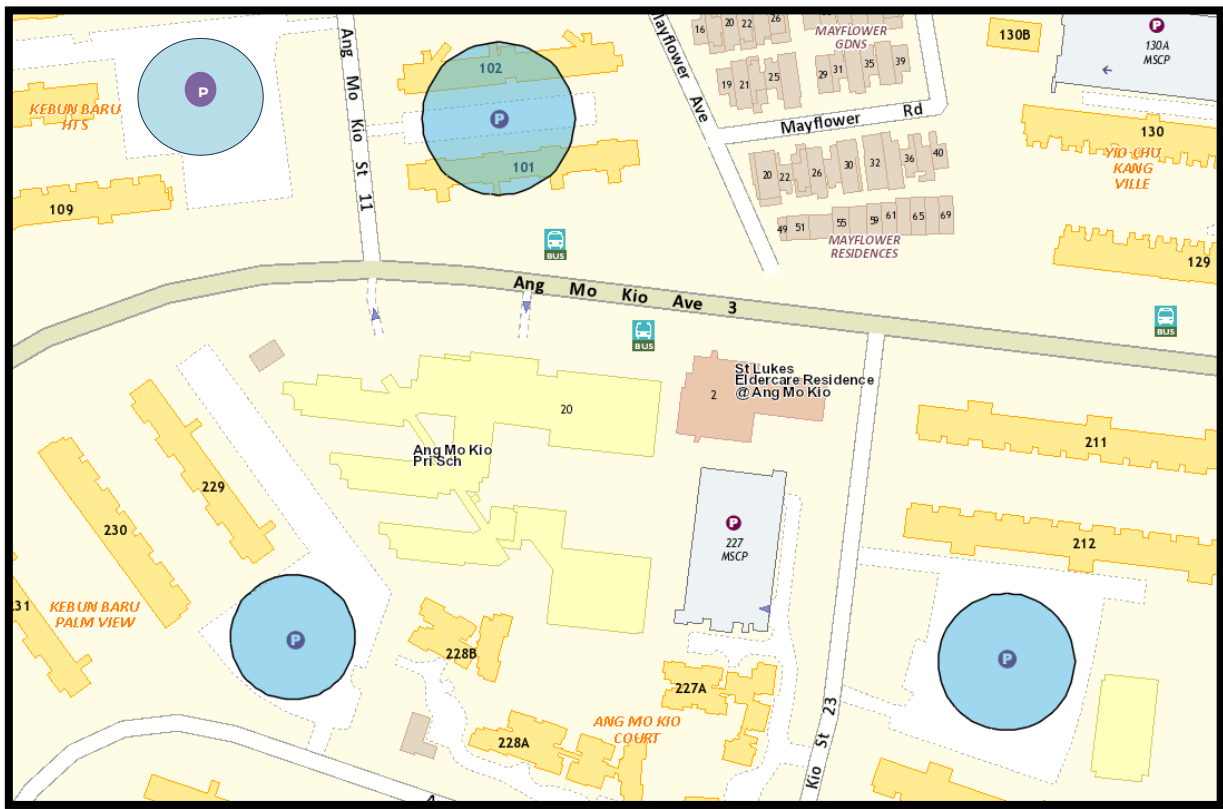
ENFORCEMENT AGAINST INCONSIDERATE PARKING / WAITING ALONG ANG MO KIO AVENUE 3

The Land Transport Authority (LTA) and Ang Mo Kio Primary School have been receiving feedback in Term 1 from the local community including fellow parents about vehicles parking and waiting indiscriminately along Ang Mo Kio Avenue 3 during school dismissal hours.

While we understand the need for parents / guardians to pick up their children, such inconsiderate parking has caused inconvenience and obstruction to traffic along the mentioned roads. Such motorists' behaviour also poses a significant risk to children who might not be easily seen when parked vehicles block them from the view of other vehicles traveling along the road.

For the safety of all road users, we urge all motorists to exercise care and consideration by **NOT PARKING / WAITING** along the mentioned roads with enforcement lines.

We encourage parents / guardians to **PLAN** your pick-up time with your child and arrive at the school only when you are ready to perform **IMMEDIATE PICK-UP**. If you arrive early, please park first at designated car parks near the location.



The authorities **WILL NOT hesitate to take enforcement actions** against errant motorists who flout traffic rules and regulations. Offenders are liable to face the following penalties:
