2. Recap of Term 2 Key Activities: Nurturing Hearts and Minds

Term 2 has been filled with meaningful learning experiences that continue to nurture our students as **Confident Persons, Joyful Learners and Caring Citizens**. Through our Applied Learning Programme (ALP) in Oracy, students have developed confidence and communication skills in authentic settings. Our Book Blast initiative provided opportunities for our young storytellers to share their favourite stories with peers, strengthening their ability to express ideas clearly and connect meaningfully with others. Students also showcased their creativity and talents through the inaugural '*Voices of AMKP*' newsletter (written for the student community by students) and the '*Kaleidoscope*' broadcast, where they celebrated school experiences and demonstrated the diverse strengths within the AMKPian community. At the same time, our Primary 5 students further developed their digital literacy through the Code-for-Fun programme, applying computational thinking, creativity and teamwork through coding and robotics.

Beyond the classroom, our students continued to develop empathy, resilience and a strong sense of community through a range of character-building and citizenship programmes. Through ActiveX Playdate, student leaders forged intergenerational friendships with seniors from THK Active Ageing Centre @ AMK 208, demonstrating Care through service and active engagement. The Drug Remembrance Programme guided students in making safe and responsible choices, while cultural learning experiences such as Together-Raya, the *Singapo* 人 exhibition, strengthened appreciation of cultural diversity and identity. These rich and authentic learning experiences reflect AMKP's commitment to nurturing every child holistically, equipping them with the values, competencies and confidence to thrive in an ever-changing world.

Please note that persistent late-coming will affect your child/ward's overall conduct grade.**
