2025 AMKP TERMLY LETTER – TERM 4

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope the September holidays have provided your child/ward with a welcomed break. As we begin the new term, we would like to share relevant school matters and other key information.

2. Recap of Term 3 Key Activities: Nurturing Hearts and Minds

We are delighted to share how our diverse school programmes have enriched our students' development and enhanced their growth throughout Term 3, engaging them actively in meaningful learning within and beyond the classroom.

Our students celebrated National Day meaningfully by learning about the values demonstrated by our pioneers in building Singapore over the past 60 years whilst articulating their vision for a Reimagined Singapore through purposeful artwork. Our Teachers' Day celebration was equally heartwarming, where AMKPians lit up the stage with amazing performances with our beloved alumni returning to AMKP to show gratitude to the teachers who shaped them. Our Racial Harmony Day celebrations also brought the school community together as staff and students proudly wore their ethnic attire and enjoyed performances by MICappella, followed by learning about traditional games during recess. Throughout the week, students reflected on the values of respect, unity, and understanding during Form Teacher Guidance Period (FTGP) lessons.

Our students also unleashed their creativity through various programmes, including "The View from Our Window" art project where our Primary 3 students worked with Singapore artist, Miss Tan Zi Xi, to create bird-themed vinyl decals and installations along the school staircases. We were also delighted to host our School Advisory Committee Member, Mr Collin Chee, who inspired our drama club students with his acting journey and emphasised the importance of responsibility, resilience, and discipline. The excitement continued with MOLLY's visit (the National Library Board's mobile library bus) which brought the joy of reading directly to our Primary 1-3 students.

Meaningful and enriching learning continued with our Primary 6's exploration of Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve to understand mangrove ecosystems, Social Studies learning journeys for our Primary 3 and 4 students to Geylang Serai Heritage Centre to learn about the rich Malay heritage and appreciate the contributions of the different communities to the nation's growth, as well as the innovative Maker Recess Programme where our students experienced the joy and creativity of building rubber band-powered racing cars from scratch. Our Primary 5 students enjoyed their 3D2N Camp Resilience and immersed themselves in meaningful Values-in-Action projects by visiting

several residential network centres in Ang Mo Kio where they engaged residents in fun and heartwarming activities and learnt the importance of kindness, empathy, and community spirit.

These diverse programmes reflect our commitment to foregrounding a quality AMKP education in nurturing holistic and well-rounded students.

We strive to instil the value of punctuality in our students. **All students are expected to be in school by 7.30 a.m. Late arrivals (after 7.30 a.m.) will be recorded**, and a notification letter will be issued to parents for students who are late five times within five weeks. **We seek your help in ensuring that your child/ward comes to school punctually. Please note that persistent late-coming will affect your child/ward's overall conduct grade.** We also encouraged all students to report to school with a storybook and to start their day by inculcating the positive habit of reading before flag raising.
